How to find out the listing that needs to add the eBay product ID (ePID)?

eBay Product-based shopping experience (PBSE) requirement has gone to the second stage. Before the end of August, all items listed under the affected eBay category must be associated with the eBay product ID (ePID) of that product.

Login to SoldEazy, go to **Listing > Live Listing > Listing Recommendation**. Here can see all the listings that have been marked **by eBay** and required to fill in the eBay product number (ePID).

Or you can use <Export> function to export the live listing information that needs to be added ePID, and then revise the adding in the local datasheet
